Approval of Minutes

Commissioner Leal, seconded by Commissioner Powers, moved to approve the minutes from the Election Commission meeting on October 17, 2024. With a voice vote the motion passed.

Discussion/Action Items

Item C-1: Appointment of Election Inspectors for the Election on May 6, 2025

Commissioner Leal, seconded by Commissioner Powers, moved to approve the *Roster of Election Workers* for the City's one voting precinct (Precinct 10), the absent voter counting board, and the receiving board for the Parchment Schools special election to be held on May 6, 2025. With a voice vote the motion passed 2-0.

Item C-2: Absent Voter Counting Board Resolution

Commissioner Leal, seconded by Commissioner Powers, moved to adopt a RESOLUTION providing for the creation and operation of the absent voter counting board for the City of Kalamazoo for the election to be held on May 6, 2025. With a voice vote the motion passed 2-0.

Item C-3: Consolidating Precincts for the November 4, 2025 Election Resolution

Commissioner Leal, seconded by Commissioner Powers, moved to adopt a RESOLUTION consolidating precincts for the Municipal Election to be held on November 4, 2025. With a voice vote the motion passed 2-0.

Item C-4: 2025 Regular Meeting Schedule

Commissioner Leal, seconded by Commissioner Powers, moved to approve the Election Commission's 2025 Regular Meeting Schedule. With a voice vote the motion passed 2-0.

Item C-5: Public Accuracy Test

The Election Commission conducted a public accuracy test of the tabulator and program to be used for the City's one voting precinct (Precinct 10) and absent voter counting board, for the Parchment Schools special election to be held on May 6, 2025. After conducting a successful test on the tabulator to be used in Precinct 10, the Election Commission certified the results of the accuracy test and sealed the predetermined test results, test decks, and tabulator result tapes in an approved ballot container.
